September 6-7-8, 2023, Lille

This will be the central theme of this 11th edition of LCM.

The LCM (Life Cycle Management) conference series have been the world's leading conferences on environmental, social, and economic sustainability since 2001.

With over 800 participants already registered, LCM2023 conference in Lille will bring together the largest number of economic actors and experts from all over the world ever.

This 11th conference has been initiated by the United Nations Environment Program (UNEP), supported by the LCM2LOOP association, and organised by WeLOOP.

LCM 2023 in brief

At Lille Grand Palais, from 6 to 8 September 2023 (with a welcome ceremony on the 5th afternoon), more than 800 participants have already registered (78% of them international from 41 countries, divided between 45% industrial actors, 40% research actors and 15% other actors) to discuss and explore this subject in greater depth.

After 2 plenary sessions, 150 international chairs will take part in 36 sessions, and over 400 posters will be presented.

Organisers: Scientific committee (nearly 60 experts) and organisational committee (15 people) coordinated by WeLOOP, in association with UNEP and the Life Cycle Initiative.
